

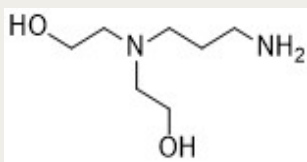

APDEA (AMINOPROPYLDIETHANOLAMINE)

Description

Aminopropyl diethanolamine (APDEA) is a pale pink to light brown liquid. APDEA can be used as a chain extender or co-curing agent for various coating applications and as reactive intermediate for numerous chemical reactions.
